Because the proposed amendment to Rule 6(e) indicates that the filing of a timely memoranda is only required if movant is "intending to do so," there appears to be some conflict with the proposed amendment to Rule 7(b), which indicates that the filing of a motion *"shall* be accompanied by a supporting memorandum which *shall* be served and filed with the motion."
